I am preparing my Thanksgiving message, and it feels like we've barely even made plans for Thanksgiving yet. (Although I do know that Turkey Ribs will be on the menu...) Christmas and the New Year will be here before I know it.

No matter what season it is or how busy you are, it is important to spend time in God's Word. I hope that the Advent reading plan and The Bible Recap will be great resources for your personal devotions. Let us grow in our knowledge of the Lord and our love for him together!


